

# PDK COVID-19 Interim Policies

Updated May 2022

Masks are still required in a health care setting

The following steps are being taken to improve safety for our patient families and team members:

- **SCREENINGS:** We will be performing same-day wellness screenings. Appointments may need to be rescheduled based on the answers provided.
- **UPON ARRIVAL:**
  - We ask that your family send us a text (or call) and remain in your car.
  - A same-day wellness screening will be conducted via telephone.
- **TO ENCOURAGE SOCIAL DISTANCING:**
  - We ask to minimize number of people coming back with the child for their appointment
  - Children are encouraged to be back for appointments on their own when possible.
  - There is limited seating in the wait/reception area. We ask that individuals not receiving care wait in the car for the entirety of the appointment.
- **MASKS:**
  - All patients over the age of 5 and accompanying adults entering the clinic will be asked to wear a mask. Children ages 2-5 are encouraged to wear a mask when possible.
  - The mask is to be worn at all times in the clinic, unless actively receiving dental care.
- **SEATING:**
  - Our reception area and clinic will remain free of magazines and toys. The arcade game will not be available for use. Please bring whatever your child may require.
- **AEROSOL GENERATING PROCEDURES:** will be minimized or isolated to closed rooms.
- **TEAM:** All team members are required to be vaccinated against Covid 19.
